Principal's Message


We have now reached the halfway point of the school year. With the halfway point being here, I would like to take a minute to reflect on the importance of celebrating success.




Guess who clinched the grand prize? A bunch of wicked online Physical Education students who not only slayed their teachers in the final end but also bagged double activity credits!

Get ready for a wild, watery adventure as our elementary students took on the mighty Columbia and Kootenay River watersheds, straight from the Ktunaxa Creation Story!



Your PAC committee meets monthly and is equally excited about the school year. We are especially excited to launch a SAVE-ON-SPONSORED Grocery Card fundraiser. Cards purchased can be used at any Save-On location – Canada wide. And you do not need to attend KDS to purchase, so please tell all your friends. Here is how it will work:

- 1. Email <u>KDSpac2022@gmail.com</u> your desired dollar amount of cards. Please include amount, name, and contact info. Please provide this information before the end of the month.
- 2. At the beginning of the following month, we will notify you to e-transfer funds to:

 <u>KDSpac2022@gmail.com</u> please use the password GROCERY. Once we receive your funds, we will pick them up and leave them with Christine at the Front Desk at KDS/Fernie for pick up. (We will also deliver cards to Cranbrook and leave with the school.)
- 3. When you pick up your cards from the school, you will need to wait 48 hours for the activation to clear.

And then SAVE ON donates 8% of total cards purchased to KDS! This year, the PAC committee is using fundraising profits to support our teachers with additional supplies needed for students. Know your grocery card purchase is going to a really fantastic cause that supports both teachers and students.
